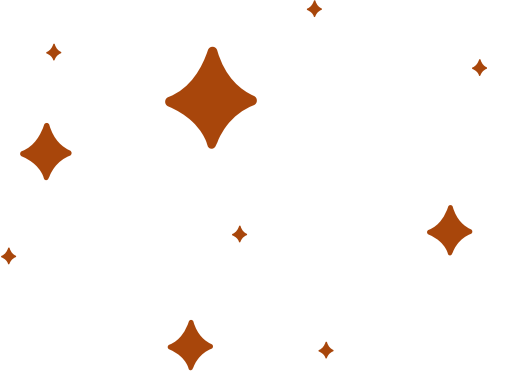

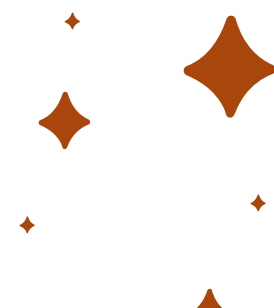

Priming of Plant Immunity

The sensitization of stress responsiveness during induced resistance is called priming.

Naive state → Priming → Primed state

Defence → Biotic attack (Primary stimulus) → DEFENCE

Priming boosts the plant's defensive capacity and brings it into an alarmed state of defence.
