


Fig5: Distribution of Critically ill patients according to their diagnosis

ACCUMULATION

INTRODUCTION

- Malnutrition is one of the most common problem in India.
- Malnutrition is defined as "a state wherein adequate nutrients are not delivered to the cells to provide the substrate for optimal functioning."¹
- In 2017, globally there were **151 million** children under 5 year of age **stunted** and **51 million wasted**.^{2*}
- Poor nutrition in the first 1,000 days of a child's life can also lead to stunted growth, which is associated with impaired cognitive ability and reduced school and work performance.^{3**}

Research has revealed

- 92% of teens say that they go online daily, while 24% consider themselves to be online "almost constantly."
- Over half of teenagers go online many times a day.
- 94% of teenagers access the Internet via their smartphones at least once a day, if not more.
- Facebook is the most-commonly visited social media site for teens (71%), followed by Instagram (52%), then Snapchat (44%).




Introduction

- Bed rest is considered as the routine standard of care in Intensive Care Units (ICUs) which leads to immobility, deconditioning, and weakness.
- Prolonged bed rest and inactivity lead to decreased skeletal muscle use which results in decreased muscle synthesis and increased proteolysis with eventual muscle catabolism, atrophy and weakness.
- The intensive care unit acquired weakness (ICUAW) is associated with joint contractures, thromboembolism, resistance to insulin, micro vascular alterations, pressure ulcers, pneumonia, extension of the weaning period, delirium, increase in the days of income, increased mortality, and development of disabilities.
- It is also characterized by fatigue and profound neuromuscular weakness.
